Thursday, April 7 <sup>th</sup>	The Boasting Tongue	Proverbs 27:1-2 I Corinthians 4:7 2 Corinthians 10:18 Psalms 49:20	"By the grace of God, I am what I am" I Corinthians 15:10
Friday, April 8 <sup>th</sup>	The Self-Deprecating Tongue	Judges 6:11-16 Philippians 4:13 Ephesians 3:20	God is able to make all grace abound toward me; so that I always have all things, may abound to every good work.

Saturday, April 9 <sup>th</sup>	The Slandering Tongue	Proverbs 10:18 Ephesians 4:31-32 Titus 2:3 Psalms 15:1-3	I refuse to be a slanderer. I will use Philippians 4:8 as my conversation sifter.
