Monday, April 18 th	The Intimidating Tongue	Philippians 1:28 Psalms 38:12-15 Acts 4:29	Because God is in control of every aspect of my life and has set my destiny, I have no need to control the behavior of others.
Tuesday, April 19 th	The Rude Tongue	Proverbs 18:13 Proverbs 30:32-33 I Corinthians 13:4-5 Isaiah 35:8	I will slow down and take the time to do unto others as I would have them do unto me.
Wednesday, April 20 th	The Judgmental Tongue	Matthew 7:1-2 Romans 2:1 James 4:12 Proverbs 25:8,12	I do not judge others or I too will be judged. For in the same way that I judge, I will be judged.
Thursday, April 21 st	The Self-Absorbed Tongue	Philippians 2:4 II Timothy 3:1,5 Galatians 6:2 Proverbs 18:1	I look not only to my own interests, but to the interest of others. Therefore, my issues are not the primary topic of my conversations.
Friday, April 22 nd	The Cursing Tongue	James 3:8-10 Ephesians 5:4-5 Leviticus 19:12 Psalm 34:13	Cursing does not proceed out of my mouth. Today I give God full charge of my tongue. By his grace I will only speak words that will bring honor to His name.
Saturday, April 23 rd	The Complaining Tongue	Philippians 2:14 Psalm 50:23 James 5:9 Romans 1:21 Psalm 119:108 Psalm 142:1-2	Because God works all things together for my good, according to His purpose for my life, I will not complain.
Sunday, April 24 th	The Retaliating Tongue	I Peter 3:9 Psalm 94:1 I Peter 2:23 Romans 12:17	I will not repay evil with evil or insult with insult, but with blessing, because to this I have been called so that I may inherit a blessing.
